**Attire:** All participants should dress in pants with belt loops that are suitable for the range such as jeans or 5.11 brand tactical style pants (**Shorts are not recommended**). Running/Walking Shoes or Tactical Boots (**Open Toe Shoes Not Permitted**).

#### **What to Bring:**

- 150 Rounds of Quality Ammunition For Your Handgun (Defensive Pistol I)
- 300 Rounds of Quality Ammunition for your handgun (Defensive pistol II and III)
- Knee Pads (Optional)
- Sunscreen (Optional)
